## Memorial for the Unborn


Our new website, www.rosarygarden.org, features photos of the newly dedicated garden devoted to the unborn -- the Miracle of Life Rosary Garden. This serene garden rests on the rural hillside of St. Mary's of Pine Bluff in Cross Plains. The rosary garden is open to travelers day and night; and at dusk, landscape lights illuminate the brick pathway, rock waterfall, and statues. One of the newest features of the website is an extensive photo gallery.

Over 4,000 bricks compose the garden pathway. These bricks are available to be engraved in memorandum to loved ones or as gifts to family members and friends. The engravings help to fund and beautify the garden. Bricks come in two sizes:  $4 \times 8$  inches for \$100 and  $8 \times 8$  inches for \$200. These engraved bricks are available for customization and can be purchased directly online.

The website will be sharing pro-life updates, news, and videos from around the diocese as well as news from around the world. Check back frequently for updates on new events and activities!

An interactive map for the rosary garden is also in development. Once completed, it will allow a user to preview the garden from above and locate a specific brick on the pathway. This function will make it easier for visitors to find their bricks online among the 4,000 that populate the garden.
